NE 85th Street: One-Way Traffic Beginning Monday

The Seattle Department of Transportation is installing an improved bus stop on NE 85th Street just east of 35th Avenue NE, by the Wedgwood QFC grocery store and Rite Aid.

Starting Monday March 27, traffic on NE 85th Street will be one-way westbound from 37th Avenue NE to 35th Avenue NE. Eastbound traffic will be detoured to NE 75th Street and then to 40th Avenue NE. This detour is scheduled to remain in place for two weeks.

The work will temporarily close the Metro Transit bus stop eastbound on Northeast 85th Street just east of 35th Avenue Northeast. Metro passengers should look for Rider Alert signs directing them to a temporary stop near 38th Avenue Northeast, or call Metro's Rider Information at 206-553-3000.

This work is a part of the street improvements SDOT is making to arterial streets in the area, including 35th Avenue Northeast, NE 65th Street, and NE 75th Street, to improve safety and make it easier to get around the city.

The Seattle Department of Transportation builds, maintains and operates Seattle's \$8 billion transportation infrastructure. To further Mayor Nickels' goal to get Seattle moving, the department manages short- and long-term investments in streets, bridges, pavement and trees, that better connect the city with the region.
