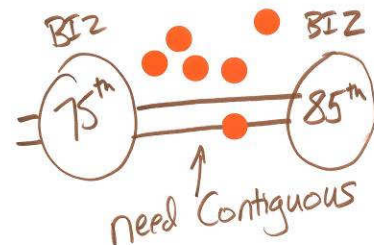


Wedgwood Vision

Exercise 1 Results Summary

Green Spaces

- Trees (especially evergreen trees) and native vegetation are valued
- Gardening is important in the community
- Undeveloped green spaces, ravines should remain
- Drainage could be improved using innovative drainage techniques
- Parks could be improved in the neighborhood
 - Need a playground
 - Want a variety of parks (small ones that are easily accessible)



Residential/ Community

- Single-family character
 - Leave it to Beaver' character
 - Modest homes
 - Modest lots that emphasize gardens in front
 - Pride of ownership
- Community
 - Stable community - people stay here
 - Social and friendly community
 - Lots of activities for kids
 - Neighbors are the most important
 - Low crime makes neighborhood livable
 - Would like a broader range of age groups (more kids please!)
- Would like more diversity of housing types including more affordable options

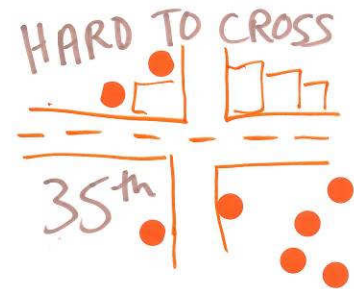
Commercial

- Small, independent businesses are valued and supported
 - Friendly taverns!
- The human/pedestrian-scale of the commercial district is appreciated
- More diverse retail is desired
 - Hardware store
- Businesses should be more concentrated on 35th
 - Connect area between 75th and 85th
 - Create more walkable environment
 - Create a 'center'
- New development should fit the character of the neighborhood

- Progressive landscaping standards for new commercial development
- Height limits and design standards
- Want a farmer's market

Transportation

- Walkability
 - Good proximity to the Burke Gilman
 - 35th Ave NE is not safe or pleasant for pedestrians and it is difficult to cross
 - Need traffic calming features on non-arterial streets
 - Hilly parts of the neighborhood are NOT walkable
 - Need better safety for kids to walk to school
- Transit
 - Feeder bus/shuttle system to serve major routes on perimeter of neighborhood (like Microsoft)
 - Bus service needs to be improved and express buses should run more frequently
 - No transit to children's hospital - a lot of people work there
- Other
 - Wedgwood has good access to the rest of the City
 - Need to be more bike friendly for kids and adults
 - Need universal accessibility (safety for wheelchairs)
 - Access to post office is dangerous and difficult



Need better safety for kids to walk to school



Other

- Local library, post office
- People like diversity of places of worship, faiths
- People pick up after dogs
- Hunters Tree Farm is not well used throughout the year
- Promote local food (food gardening, farmer's market)
- Need free/cheap community gathering space/meeting space
- Need to improve safety at night (improve lighting)
- Zero carbon footprint
